

STEP 1 - Get all your materials

Specific Requirements:

☐ Felt 25x18cm / 10x7inches wide.



General sewing supplies (thread, needles, scissors, etc).

Fabric marker.



STEP 2 - Layout

☐ The felt diaper/nappy can be made from wool felt or synthetic felt.

STEP 3

☐ Glue the pattern piece onto thick paper or card and cut out the DIAPER/NAPPY PIECE to make your template.





STEP 4

☐ Trace the Diaper / Nappy PIECE onto the felt with a fabric pen or permanent marker and cut it out.

* TIP

I love using an air-erasable pen as it fades to nothing after a short while!

STEP 5

☐ Cut a piece of velcro, open it so you have 2 pieces, 1 fluffy piece and 1 with hooks.

* TIP:

Cut off the corners as they can be quite sharp and scatchy



STEP 6a

- ☐ Pin one piece of the velcro (the fluffy piece) onto the front of one of the sides.
- Pin the other piece (with the hooks) to the back of the other side. I have flapped over one this side so you can see the velcro pinned to the back!



STEP 7

- ☐ Cut 2 more pieces of velcro, open them so you have 4 pieces, 2 fluffy pieces and 2 with hooks.
- □ Pin the 2 pieces with hooks on to the back of the DIAPER/NAPPY PIECE.



STEP 8

- ☐ Sew these velcro pieces in position. (I sewed back and forth between the 2 pieces to make my stitching look like a safety/diaper pin!)
- ☐ Use 2 pins to work out where to place the fluffy velcro bits on the sides of the diaper piece.



STEP 9

☐ Use the fabric marker to mark the postion for the fluffy velcro pieces and sew them over these markings. Your nappy should fit perfectly!



STEP 10

☐ The simplest way to fit your diaper/nappy on your baby Kutie is with a safety pin!

*TIP

I use a safety pin if the toy is for an older child and sew on velcro if the toy if for a child under the age of 3 years old.



STEP 11

☐ You can decorate you diaper/nappy pin with a cute button to add some fun detail to your toy.



STEP 12

☐ Admire your cute bub!!!! :)

Have fun dressing your kuties!
